_____ **School Library Assistant** – Help on a regular basis in the school library.

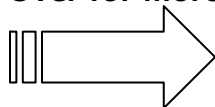
_____ **Clinic Assistant** – No experience necessary! Help on an “as-needed” basis during health screening or when the school nurse is absent.
